

You know your Honor this was blown all up by the media. I dont know

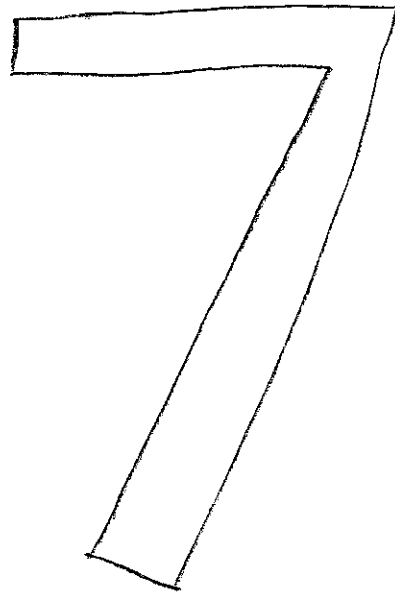
